The Word-Letter cell contains the first letter of each word in the verse preceding it. A helpful way of memorizing the verse is to copy it on an index card, using the (ref- Scripture to memorize -ref) pattern on the front side and the (ref-Word-Letter Code-ref) pattern on the back side.

Writing the reference before and after helps to remember where the verse is located in the bible. Repeat it as you read the verse, aloud if possible. Associating the words with the first letter and then using that word-letter code helps to focus more specifically on each word.

I hope you enjoy learning and memorizing these verses with us this year. The more we can remember of the word, the more the Holy has to work with as He leads us and directs us each day.
